What is this?

- Yenton has a Safeguarding Policy for staff, families and governors.
- This is a 'child friendly' version of the policy.

What is it for?

- To help you decide what could be a 'problem' and where to get help and support.

How will we try to protect children?

- We try to provide a safe environment for children to learn in.
- We want to ensure that children remain safe, at home as well as at school.
- We think it is important for all of our children to know where to get help if they are worried or unhappy about something.

If you need to talk - we will listen!

- You can talk to any adult in school!
- It is Ms. Webster's special job to keep you safe-talk to her if you are worried.
- You can ask a friend to go with you to tell an adult.

Don't keep it a secret if someone is:

- Bullying you

- Saying things to you that you do not like or upsets you
- Touching you in a way you do not like
- Trying to give you tablets, cigarettes, drugs or alcohol
- Hitting you or hurting you
- Sending unkind messages on the internet or to your phone
- You see something on the internet that upsets or worries you.
- Someone off the internet asks you to do something which upsets or worries you
- Telling you to do things that upset you

Always remember... **BUDDY!**

- Understanding other people's feelings
- Doing the best you can
- Don't keep sad feelings to yourself
- You have the right to be safe and happy.
